FY25/26 State Budget

- □ Chapter 725 is current state budget for FY25/FY26 (ends June 30, 2026)
- □FY26 state budget is \$92.5 billion; 1/3 general funds (GF)/state revenue sources; two-thirds non-general funds (NGF)
- $\square$ NGF: Federal funds received (Medicaid); higher education operating; federal transportation funds are "Top 3" (3/4 of the 2/3)

Federal and State Funds

- □ Federal funds take form of:
  - Non discretionary/formula funding— FTA, FHWA HOME, EDA, ARC, etc. that pass through the state budget/state agencies; and
  - □ Discretionary/grant funding.
- □ State funds are direct or grant-based GF appropriation.

### PDC Funding

- □ Funding for Planning District Commissions is state GF through DHCD
- □ Base funding payments made quarterly by DHCD (following annual report by PDCs and after contract execution)
- □ 18 of 21 PDCs receive \$114,971, with amounts higher for NVRC, HRPDC and PlanRVa.
