### **GIS Technician and Regional Planner**

The Northern Shenandoah Valley Commission (NSVRC), a Virginia Planning District Commission, is seeking a qualified individual to serve as a GIS Technician and Regional Planner to serve GIS needs of jurisdictions within the region, as well as support GIS initiatives within the NSVRC's internal program areas, and serve as a regional planner for the organization as primary GIS duties permit.

NSVRC seeks a highly motivated individual interested in joining a team of ten professionals who work to plan and implement collaborative efforts among the Counties of Clarke, Frederick, Page, Shenandoah, Warren, and the City of Winchester. This position will report to the Executive Director. Remote work is allowed, with the exception of required office hours set forth in jurisdictional support contracts, the necessary attendance of meetings at the NSVRC offices, municipal offices, other locations within the region, and occasional training or meeting requirements outside the region. On-site physical presence is to be expected a minimum of three days per week, likely at the Page County Administration Offices in Luray, VA, with duties requiring additional on-site presence at locations within the region from time to time.

The position is open until filled, with priority review of applications beginning on April 24<sup>th</sup>, salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience, and the position may be filled by a qualified applicant at the entry, mid, or senior level, dependent upon the total package of successful applicant's skillset. All levels of experience are encouraged to apply, though a bachelor's degree in a relevant field and two years' experience is required.
