The redevelopment of Williamsburg Prince George Street corridor illustrates the success of public and private investment in Williamsburg. Led by a multi-million-dollar public streetscape investment, the formerly quiet block now boasts five restaurants, a brewery, 14 offices, 21 apartments, a B&B, and a clothing boutique.

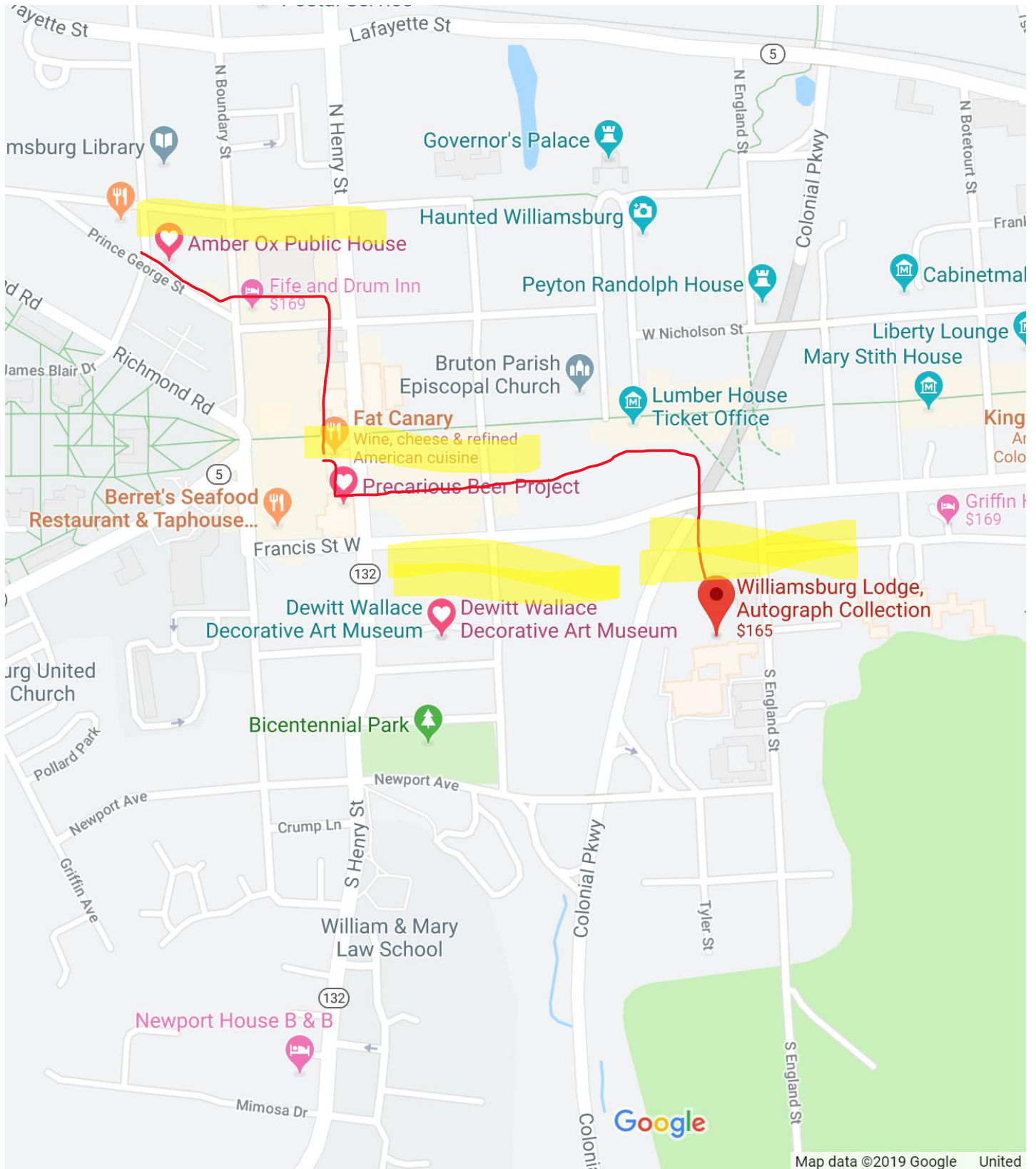
