What is Vision Zero?

If you were asked, "What is an acceptable number of roadway deaths for your family?" Wouldn't we all say zero? ***This IS Vision Zero***, a hopeful look to the future in how we as a community can work together to prevent roadway fatalities and serious injuries.

The Roanoke Safety Action Plan is a paradigm shift in how the City thinks about roadway safety. It will lay out a new set of principles for engineering roads, educating travelers, and creating a sense of collective responsibility. The City of Roanoke is taking action and committing to zero traffic deaths and serious injuries by 2035.
